Claims

- The product has XLR sockets for DMX input and output.
- Notice: This control circuit is isolated and belongs to the Class 2 data port.

The control circuit has a cumulative leakage current of less than 3.5 mA.

This product contains no user-serviceable parts. Any reference to servicing in this User Manual will only apply to properly trained, certified technicians. Do not open the housing or attempt any repairs.



All applicable local codes and regulations apply to proper installation of this product.

- The luminaire is intended for professional use only.
- The luminaire should be positioned so that prolonged staring into the luminaire at a distance closer than 11.5 ft (3.5 m) is not expected.
- If the external flexible cable or cord of this luminaire is damaged, it shall be replaced by a special cord or cord exclusively available from the manufacturer or its service agent.
- The light source contained in this luminaire shall only be replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent or a similar qualified person.
- **CAUTION:**
 - This product's housing may be hot when operating. Mount this product in a location with adequate ventilation, at least 20 in (50 cm) from adjacent surfaces.
 - When transferring the product from extreme temperature environments, (e.g., cold truck to warm humid ballroom) condensation may form on the internal electronics of the product. To avoid causing a failure, allow the product to fully acclimate to the surrounding environment before connecting it to power.

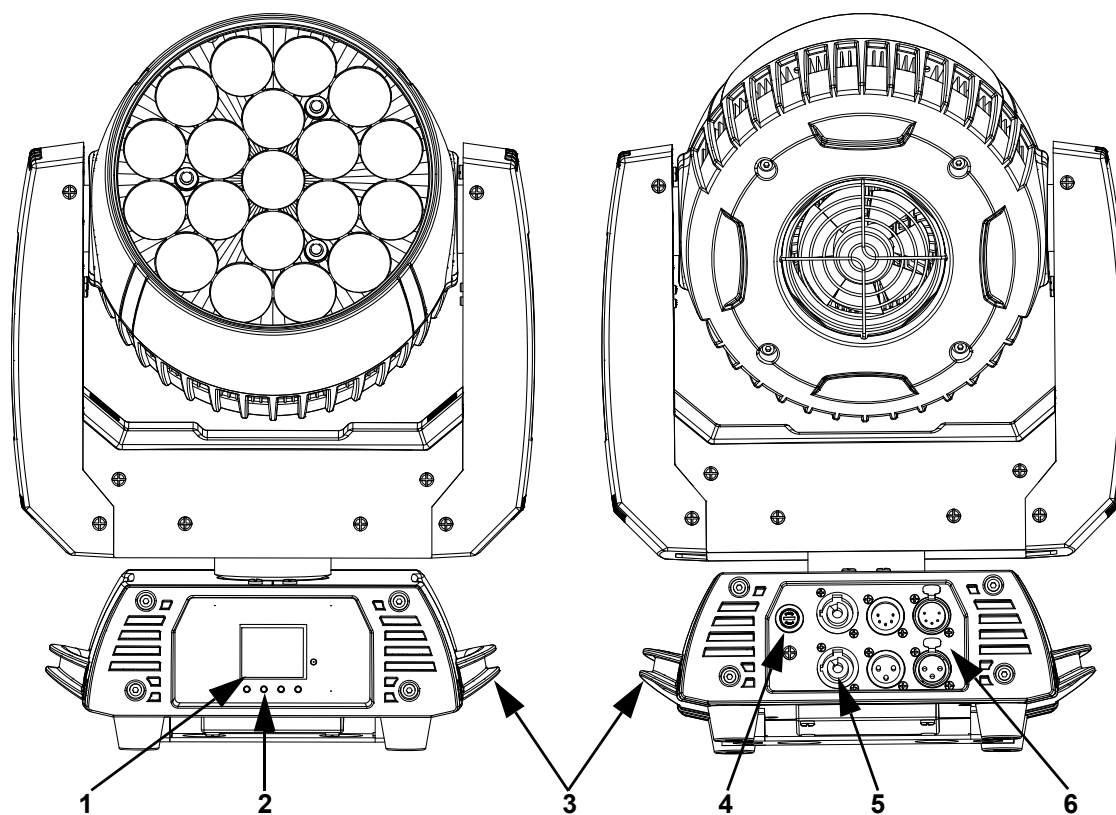

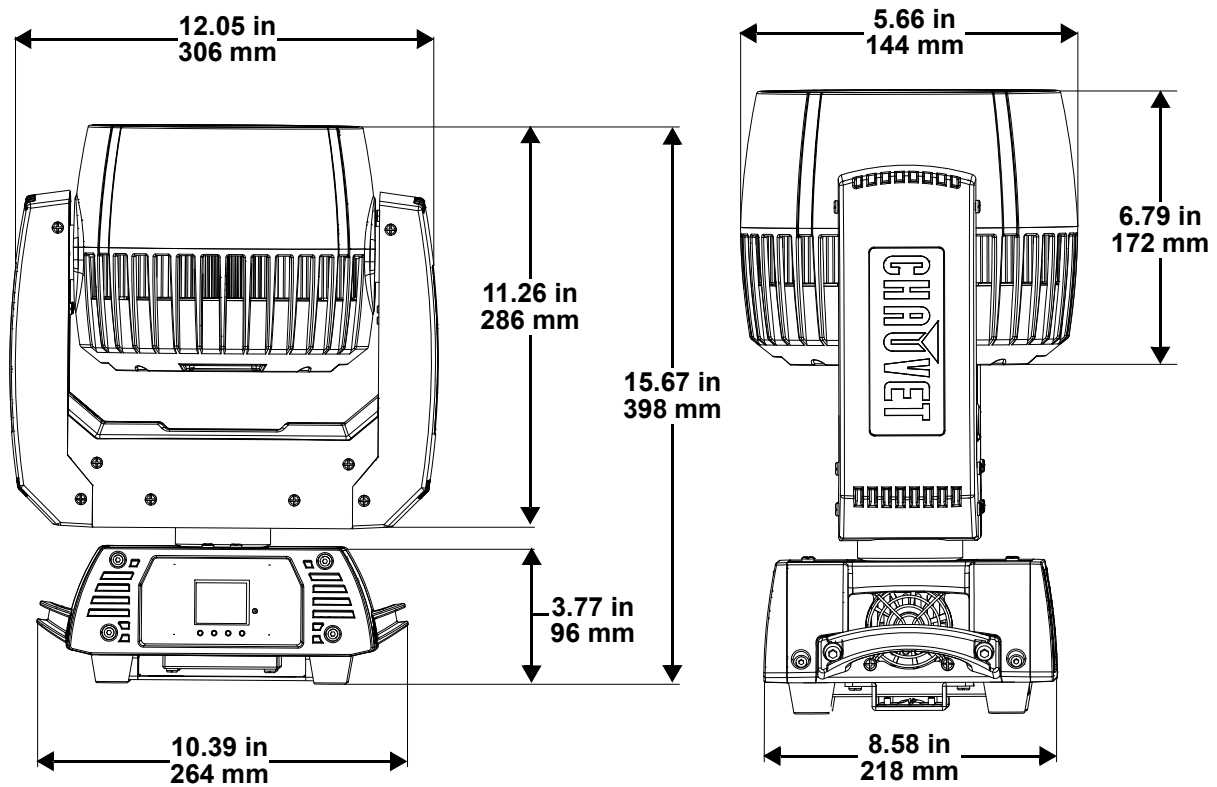

3. Setup

AC Power

The Rogue R2X Wash has an auto-ranging power supply and it can work with an input voltage range of 100 to 240 VAC, 50/60 Hz.

To determine the product's power requirements (circuit breaker, power outlet, and wiring), use the current value listed on the label affixed to the product's back panel, or refer to the product's specifications chart. The listed current rating indicates the product's average current draw under normal conditions.



- **Always connect the product to a protected circuit (a circuit breaker or fuse). Make sure the product has an appropriate electrical ground to avoid the risk of electrocution or fire.**
- **To eliminate unnecessary wear and improve its lifespan, during periods of non-use completely disconnect the product from power via breaker or by unplugging it.**



Never connect the product to a rheostat (variable resistor) or dimmer circuit, even if the rheostat or dimmer channel serves only as a 0 to 100% switch.

AC Plug

The Rogue R2X Wash comes with a power input cord terminated with a Seetronic Powerkon A connector on one end and an Edison plug on the other end (U.S. market). If the power input cord that came with the product has no plug, or if it is necessary to change the plug, use the table below to wire the new plug.

Power Linking

It is possible to power link Rogue R2X Wash products. See the table below for the current draw at each voltage and frequency:

Never exceed 12A on a single circuit. Power-linking cables can be purchased separately.

Fuse Replacement

1. Disconnect this product from the power outlet.
2. Using a flat-head screwdriver, unscrew the fuse holder cap from the housing.
3. Remove the blown fuse and replace with another fuse of the same type and rating (F5A, 250 V).
4. Screw the fuse holder cap back in place and reconnect power.

Remote Device Management

Remote Device Management, or RDM, is a standard for allowing DMX-enabled devices to communicate bi-directionally along existing DMX cabling. Check the DMX controller's User Manual or with the manufacturer as not all DMX controllers have this capability. The Rogue R2X Wash supports RDM protocol that allows feedback to make changes to menu map options.

Mounting

Before mounting the product, read and follow the safety recommendations indicated in the [Safety Notes](#). For our Chauvet Professional line of mounting clamps, go to <http://trusst.com/products/>.

Orientation

Always mount this product in a safe position, making sure there is adequate room for ventilation, configuration, and maintenance.

Rigging

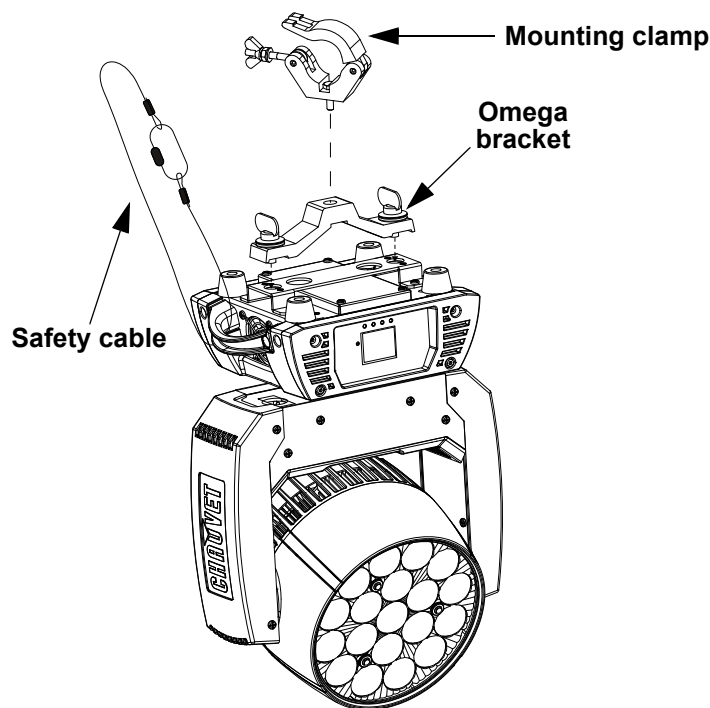
Chauvet recommends using the following general guidelines when mounting this product.

- Before deciding on a location, always make sure there is easy access to the product for maintenance and programming.
- Make sure that the structure onto which the product is being mounted can support the product's weight. See the [Technical Specifications](#).
- When mounting the product overhead, always use a safety cable. Mount the product securely to a rigging point, whether an elevated platform or a truss.
- When rigging the product onto a truss, use a mounting clamp of appropriate weight capacity.

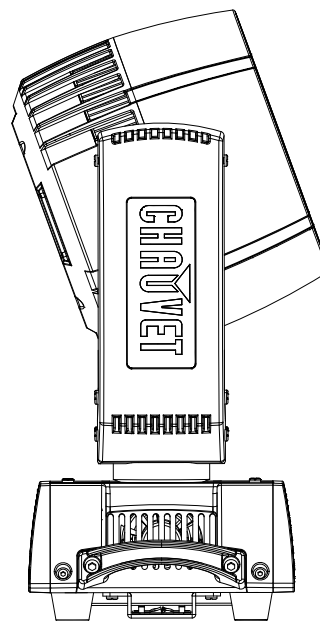
Procedure

The Rogue R2X Wash comes with omega brackets to which the user can directly attach mounting clamps (sold separately). Make sure the clamps are capable of supporting the weight of this product. 4. Operation

Control Panel Description

Button	Function
<MENU>	Exits from the current menu or function
<UP>	Enables the currently displayed menu or sets the currently selected value in to the current function
<DOWN>	Navigates upward through the menu list or increases the numeric value when in a function
<ENTER>	Navigates downward through the menu list or decreases the numeric value when in a function

Control Options

Set the Rogue R2X Wash starting address in the **001–512** DMX range.

Programming

Refer to the Menu Map to understand the menu options. The menu map shows the main level and a variable number of programming levels for each option.

- To go to the desired main level, press **<MENU>** repeatedly until the option shows on the display. Press **<ENTER>** to select. This will navigate to the first programming level for that option.
- To select an option or value within the current programming level, press **<UP>** or **<DOWN>** until the option shows on the display. Press **<ENTER>** to select. In this case, if there is another programming level, it will appear as the first option, or the user will see the selected value.
- Press **<MENU>** repeatedly to exit to the previous main level.

Configuration

Use control configurations to operate the product with a DMX controller.

Control Personalities

To set the control personality:

1. Go to the **Run Mode** main level.
2. Select the **DMX** option.
3. Select the desired personality, from **15CH**, **17CH**, **22CH**, **33CH**, **33CH MS**, **54CH**, **54CH MS**, or **56CH**.
 - See the [Starting Address](#) section for the highest starting address that can be selected for each personality.
 - Make sure that the starting addresses on the various products do not overlap due to the new personality setting.



Starting Address

Each product will respond to a unique starting address from the controller. All products with the same starting address will respond in unison. To set the starting address:

1. Go to the **Address** main level.
2. Select the starting address (**001–512**).

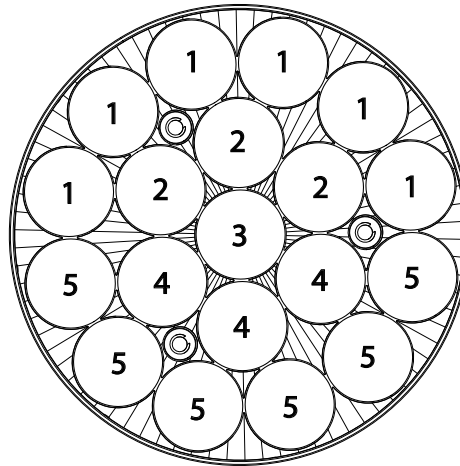

The Offset mode provides fine adjustments for the home position of every moving part in the optical path as well as the pan and tilt movements. To adjust these options and prevent borders showing or reduction of the light output:

1. From the main level screen, press and hold **<MENU>** until the passcode screen appears.
2. Enter the passcode: **2323** and press **<ENTER>**.
3. Select the "zero" position to adjust, from **PAN**, **TILT**, or **ZOOM**.
4. Adjust the "zero" position for the selected function from **000–255**.

5. Maintenance

Product Maintenance

Dust build-up reduces light output performance and can cause overheating. This can lead to reduction of the light source's life and/or mechanical wear. To maintain optimum performance and minimize wear, clean the lighting products at least twice a month. However, be aware that usage and environmental conditions could be contributing factors to increase the cleaning frequency.

To clean the product, follow the instructions below:

1. Unplug the product from power.
2. Wait until the product is at room temperature.
3. Use a vacuum (or dry compressed air) and a soft brush to remove dust collected on the external surface/vents.
4. Clean all transparent surfaces with a mild soap solution or ammonia-free glass cleaner.
5. Apply the solution directly to a soft, lint free cotton cloth or a lens cleaning tissue.
6. Softly drag any dirt or grime to the outside of the transparent surface.
7. Gently polish the transparent surfaces until they are free of haze and lint.

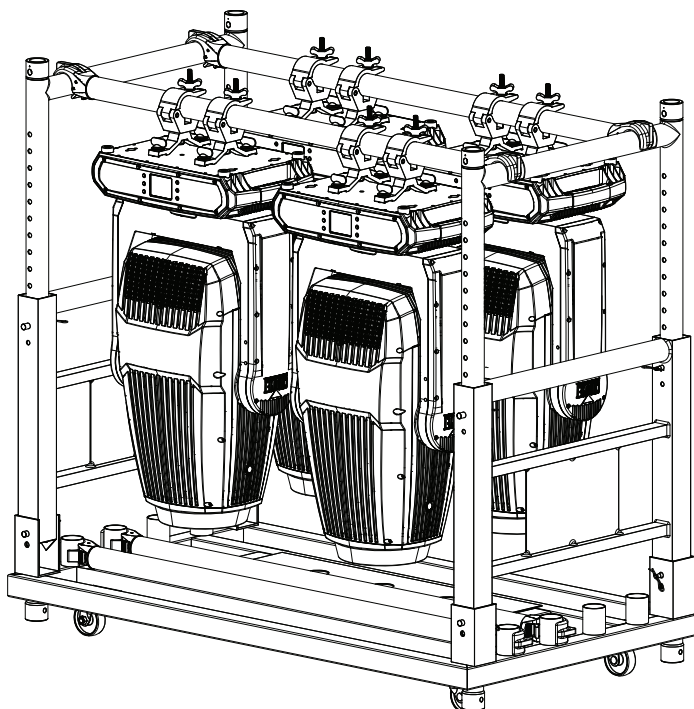


Always dry the transparent surfaces carefully after cleaning them.



Do not spin the cooling fans with compressed air. Damage may result.

Transporting on Truss or Racks



When transporting fixtures in pre-rigged truss and transportation racks, mount fixtures in the vertical position with the lenses facing down and the pan and tilt locks engaged. This is to prevent undue stress on the tilt locks and limit the amount of off-axis bounce on internal components.
